On behalf of the Honduras Sister Parish Committee, I would like to express our sincere gratitude for your generous donation in support of our Sister Parish in Nueva Palestina, Honduras.

It was 20 years ago (2001) that Saint Michael Church sent the first delegation to visit our Sister Parish in Honduras, and each year thereafter, (with the exception of 2021 due to Covid). We were fortunate to send another delegation in March of this year, witnessing the impact your donations have been making over this period can only be described as unbelievable.

The building of a new church, convent and community center have been life changing for our Sister Parish, and their parishioner's spiritual lives, growth, and community.

Most importantly, the water filtration systems, latrines, smokeless ovens, new roofs, and floors that we have installed, along with our education, medical and agricultural programs have significantly improved the quality of life for "thousands" of families.

Our Christian brothers and sisters now have purified water, concrete floors, roofs that don't leak, latrines that provide sanitation, and smokeless ovens which reduce firewood consumption up to 70%. Our ministry is dedicated to raising the standards for quality of life, health, sustainability, and spiritual growth in these under-developed areas.

You are making a tremendous difference. Thank you for helping us make this all happen in Jesus's name.
